





Replacing and Installing a Ball Chute Trap Door on your Elite 3 & Pickle 2.

	<p style="text-align: center;">Removing The Case</p> <p>Step 1.) Unscrew the (6) Phillips-head screws along the bottom of the red case where it attaches to the chassis of the machine. (2-front, 2-rear, one on each side)</p> <p>Step 2.) Lift the red case off the chassis and set it aside. (Make sure to not allow the Ground Wire from the case to touch the Green control board and panel- this could fry the ground wire.)</p>	<p>P2 Philips Screw Driver</p>	 <p>Case Screws (Front & Rear)</p>  <p>Case Screws (Side)</p>  <p>Case Removed</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Installing the New Ball Chute Trap Door</p> <p>Step 1.) Insert the plastic ball chute Trap Door flap so that rounded part fits into the hole that appears just above the ball detection switch (which is underneath the ball chute).</p> <p>Step 2.) Use the metal pin and push the in into the ball chute and hole that is in the ball chute Trap Door flap, until it is flush and the ball chute flap is held properly in place.</p>		 <p>Ball Chute Trap Door with hole piece in place.</p>

Testing the Ball Chute Trap Door Flap and Ball Detection Switch

Step 1.) With the case still resting beside the machine, use a long stick, or screw driver and make sure the ball detection switch clicks on the inside of the ball chute. (This is where the balls slide down, and then exit the machine). You should hear a "click" noise, and the plate (on current models) should spring back into place.

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Re-attaching The Case

Step 1.) Lift the red case and lower until it is covering the whole Chassis of the machine.

Step 2.) Screw the (6) Philips-head screws along the bottom of the red case where it attaches to the chassis of the machine. (2-front, 2-rear, one on each side)
